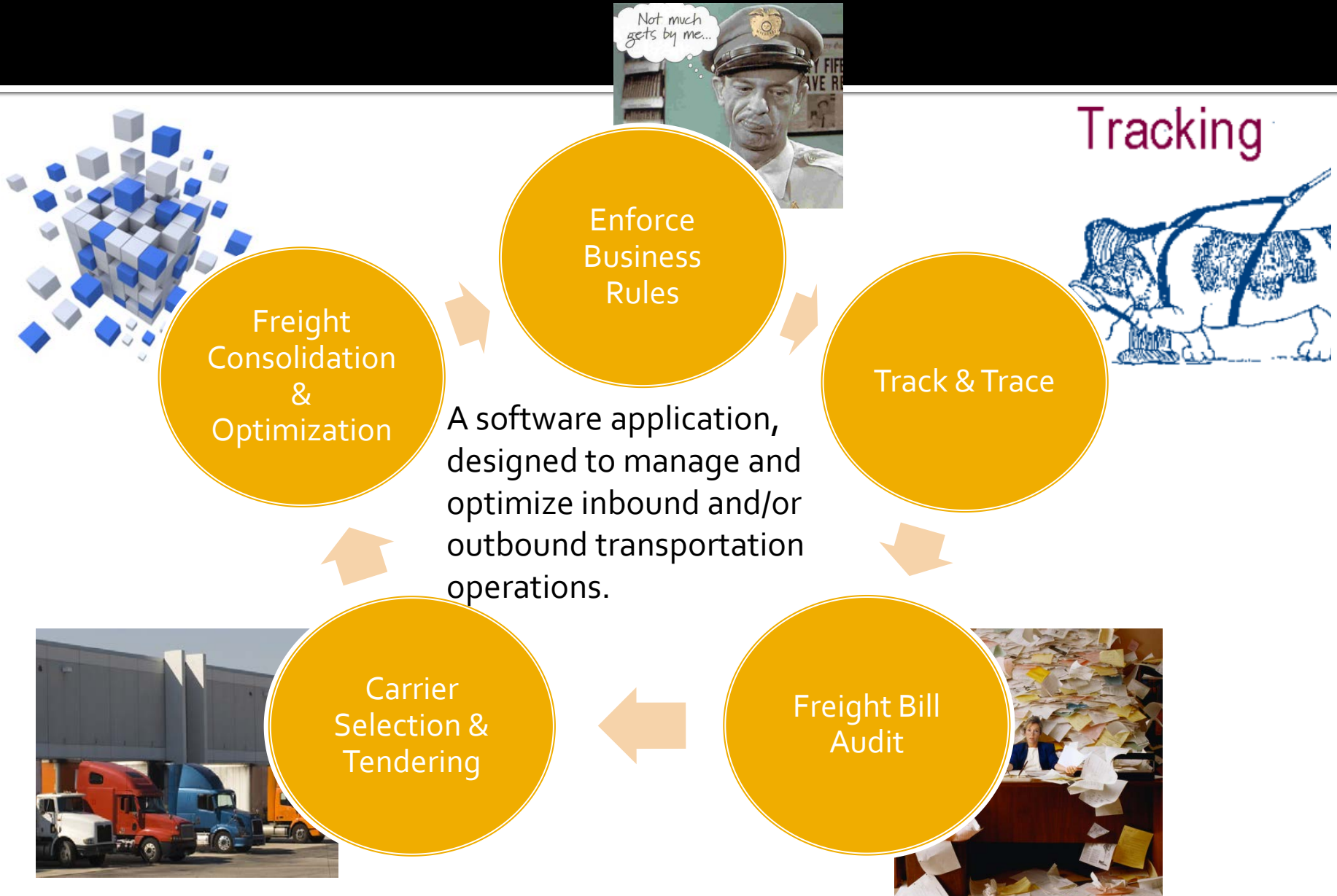

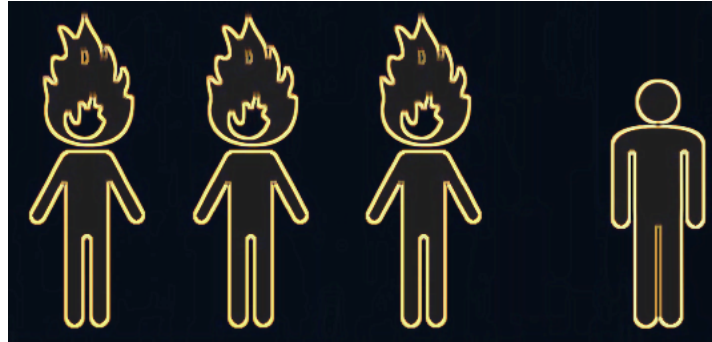




If you hear or say any of the following.....
