

BIO – James Attridge, Business Trial Lawyer, San Francisco

James Attridge is a business trial lawyer in San Francisco who has specialized in cargo loss and damage claims for over twenty years. Among his successes are Chubb Group of Insurance Companies v. H.A. Transportation which significantly limited the liability exposure of brokers. Jim also filed an amicus curiae brief in the United States Supreme Court on behalf of TLP&SA in Norfolk Southern v. Kirby. Jim has secured numerous jury verdicts including an award of over \$7.5 million dollars. He has been a guest lecturer on cargo claims law at the University of Denver College of Law. In 2005 he was named to a list of 114 Client Service All Stars by the BTI Consulting Group based upon a survey of Fortune 200 General Counsels. Jim was the Valedictorian of his class at the University of San Francisco and earned his law degree from the University of Denver where he served on the staff of the Transportation Law Journal.
